The following documents should be submitted along with the application.

- A receipt of Rupees 1,000/= paid to A/c Number 055-1001-30667553, of the People's Bank, Kelaniya Branch. The receipt could be obtained from any branch of the People's Bank.
- II. A Principal or a Justice of Peace with his official seal should certify the results of G.C.E. (A/L)-2019, Z-Score and G.C.E. (O/L) examinations.
- III. If there is a difference in the names in the certificates with the name in application, an Affidavit should be provided certifying both names are of the same person.

Applicants should possess minimum requirements, specified under section 2.2.8.2 of the handbook on "Admission to Undergraduate Programmes of the Universities in Sri Lanka for the Academic Year 2019/2020", issued by the University Grants Commission. In addition, those who apply to the UGC for admission to the universities are required to apply, sit and meet the minimum criteria set for the above aptitude test. An applicant is eligible to sit the said aptitude test if he/she possesses the following qualifications:

Obtained at least a "C" grade in one of the subjects; Higher Mathematics, Combined Mathematics, Mathematics or Physics and should have passed

 three subjects at the G.C.E. (Advance Level) Examination in Biological Science stream or Physical Science stream

 two subjects either from Biological Science stream or Physical Science stream with Information and Communication Technology (ICT) as the third subject. Applications by post should be on <u>A4 size paper</u> in strict accordance with the format given below and the perfected application should be sent under Registered Post, to reach the **Deputy Registrar / Examinations, University of Kelaniya, Dalugama, Kelaniya on or before 06th July 2020. Mark "B.Sc. Honours in MIT Degree Programme" on the top left hand corner of the envelope.**

Applications which do not meet the stipulated criteria and specified requirements will be rejected.

The aptitude test date will be informed later and conducted in the English medium.
